SUBJECT: ASPEN LTCSP 12.2.0.3 Release Information

The ASPEN LTCSP 12.2.0.3 release will be deployed to production on Saturday, February 18-2023. State and CMS staff can begin using ASPEN 12.2.0.3 by the start of business on Monday, February 20, 2023.

Included in This Release

This release includes executables for ASE-Q/LTCSP. See Release Notes below for changes included in this release.

LTCSP

LTCSP changes will take effect starting after February 20, 2023 for surveys that were exported after February 20, 2023 using the new 12.2.0.3 version of the application.

What this means for LTCSP survey teams

For this release, though we recommend teams always use the same version of LTCSP, we do not anticipate any issues if teams have some surveyors who upgrade to 12.2.0.3 and some who do not.

Download Information

ASPEN 12.2.0.3 will be provided to your state agency as a standard ASPEN thin install. The planned posting of the thin installs to the ASPEN website is by close of business on Wednesday, February 8, 2023 to allow for your agency's release planning. The download links below are not active until the thin install files are posted on February 8.

Note: No action is necessary by CMS users – these upgrades are automatically applied to your CMS systems and should not be downloaded separately from these links.
