The ASPEN LTCSP 12.2.0.3 release will be deployed to production on Saturday, February 18, 2023. State and CMS staff can begin using ASPEN 12.2.0.3 by the start of business on Monday, February 20, 2023.

This release includes executables for ASE-Q/LTCSP.

## **Thin Install Download Information**

The thin install will be posted to the ASPEN website by close of business on Wednesday, February 8, 2023 to allow for your agency's release planning. The download link below is not active until the thin install file is posted on February 8.

**Note:** No action is necessary by CMS users – these upgrades are automatically applied to your CMS systems and should not be downloaded separately.
