SUBJECT: ASPEN 12.4.0.1 Release Information

The ASPEN 12.4.0.1 release will be deployed to production on Thursday, May 11, 2023. State and CMS staff can begin using ASPEN 12.4.0.1 by the start of business on Friday, May 12, 2023.

The main features of the release are:

- New LTC regulation set
- Updated LTCSP Procedure Guide
- Updated LTCSP Entrance Conference Worksheet and Pathway documents Infection Control and Arbitration

Included in This Release

This release includes an ASE-Q/LTCSP thin install, updated LTCSP documents, and a new regulation set.

LTCSP

What this means for survey teams

It is not required, but is recommended that all survey team members use the same version of LTCSP. Without the 12.4.0.1 upgrade applied, the documents will be out of date. Surveyors can download the latest version by using the update documents option. See instructions below on how to update PDF documents in LTCSP.

Update PDF Documents in LTCSP

To update the PDF files to the latest version, surveyors must use the Update Documents option on the LTCSP Navigation menu.

To update PDF documents:

- 1. Verify you are connected to the internet.
- 2. Open a survey in LTCSP (all PDFs will be available for any survey).
- 3. The Navigation menu should be open, if not, click the menu icon to open.
- 4. Expand the **System** section, and select **Update Documents**.

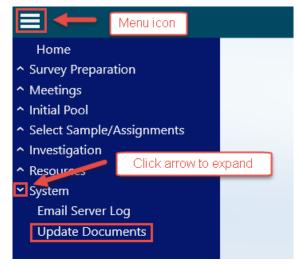


Figure 1: System menu expanded to show Update Documents option

- 5. A popup reminds you to close all open PDF documents—if open, a document cannot be updated. Click **OK**.
- 6. Click **OK** when the updates are complete.

TIP: If you get a message saying that a PDF was open and the update stops, close the PDF and rerun Update Documents.
