

ASE-Q 12.4.4.4 Release Quick Install

ASPEN Survey Explorer - Quality (ASE-Q) is designed to work as a standalone application on field computers used by surveyors when they are not connected to your agency's central network.

ASE-Q Auto-upgrade

An auto-upgrade feature is available for ASE-Q. If activated, auto-upgrade automatically applies the ASE-Q thin install for you, and you do *not* need to follow the Thin Install process described in this document.

Thin Install

The Thin Install option allows you to update only the ASE-Q application files for an existing ASE-Q installation. This makes upgrading very efficient because you do not need to run a full install program, and you skip client installation altogether.

Use the Thin Install to upgrade any computer with ASE-Q already installed. Thin Installs include all components needed to upgrade any ASE-Q 11.3 or later install.

Thin Install considerations

- Remember - if the auto-upgrade option is activated, you do not need to do a thin install.
- If the auto-upgrade option is not activated and you already have ASE-Q 11.3 or later fully installed, you will use the Thin Install process to upgrade to ASE-Q 12.4.4.4.
- If you need to install ASE-Q 12.4.4.4 on a new machine, you must follow the [“Full Install”](#) process on page 2.

Performing a Thin Install

- 1 Locate the folder containing the current ASE-Q application files. This folder is usually C:\ASPEN\ASEQ. For ASE-Q, this folder contains various files including ASE.EXE and AtgMain.DLL, and a folder called Data.
- 2 Optional: Make a backup of the folder containing the application files.
Note: Backing up the folder requires the Sybase database instance to be stopped. This may require elevated Windows permissions.
- 3 Locate the “ASE12.4.4.4_Thin.zip” file containing the updated ASE-Q files.
- 4 Unzip “ASE12.4.4.4_Thin.zip” with the ZIP program of your choice, for example, WinZip.
- 5 Extract all the files in “ASE12.4.4.4_Thin.zip” to the existing ASE-Q folder. If you are prompted to overwrite existing files, choose to do that.

The upgrade is complete.

After applying the ASE-Q 12.4.4.4 Thin Install and running it for the first time, you will be prompted to apply an upgrade patch to your ASE-Q database. Click OK on each prompt to complete the upgrade process.

Final note - Thin Install

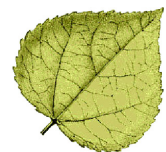
To verify that the update was successful, log into ASE-Q and make sure the ASE-Q 12.4.4.4 version is running. You can check it under the Help | About ASPEN Explorer... menu option.

Full Install

On a new computer, you will do a Full Install of ASE-Q from the ASPEN 11.3 Full Install DVD. ASE-Q computers must be running a 64-bit Windows operating system.

Note: To obtain the ASPEN 11.3 Full Install DVD, contact the QTSO Help Desk.

Before Beginning

- If you plan to use ASE-Q to connect to ACO data stored on the Oracle server, be sure the Oracle 12c client installation (included on the ASPEN 11.3 Full Install DVD) has been applied to your machine and that Oracle's TNSNAMES.ORA connection file has been properly implemented. See the *ASPEN Full Install Guide* for details; this document is included on the ASPEN 11.3 Full Install DVD.
- Make sure all applications are closed.
- You must be logged in with administrator privileges.

Performing a Full Install

- 1 Insert the ASPEN Full Install DVD.
- 2 Right-click the **Start** button on the lower left of your screen. Select **Run**, then **Browse** to view your DVD drive.
- 3 To install Oracle 12c:
Open the Oracle 12 Client folder.
Select **silent.bat**.
- 4 When the Oracle installation is complete, **Browse** to locate the folder containing the ASPEN installation files.
- 5 Select **SETUP.EXE** to launch the ASPEN Installer.

- 6 On the Welcome screen, click **Next**.
- 7 On the Select Features screen, select **ASE-Q**.
- 8 Click **Next**.
- 9 For Destination, the Installer defaults to C:\ASPEN\ASEQ or the existing ASEQ folder, if there is one. Click **Next** to accept the default location, or **Browse** to specify an alternate destination.
- 10 When the correct destination folder is displayed, click **Next**.
- 11 When Setup is complete, you may be prompted to restart your computer. Select **Yes** to restart your computer now, then select **Finish**.

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
