SUBJECT: ASPEN 12.2.0 Release Information

The ASPEN 12.2.0 release will be deployed to production on Saturday, October 22, 2022. State and CMS staff can begin using ASPEN 12.2.0 by the start of business on Monday, October 24.

Included in This Release

This release includes executables for ACO, ACTS, LTCSP and ASE-Q, and a new LTC regulation set. Details on application changes are provided below in the Release Notes section of this memo.

Download Information for State Agencies

ASPEN 12.2.0 will be provided to your state agency as standard ASPEN thin installs. The planned posting of the thin installs to the ASPEN website is by close of business on Wednesday, October 12 to allow for your agency's release planning. These download links below are not active until the thin install files are posted on the 12th.

Note: No action is necessary by CMS users – these upgrades are automatically applied to your CMS systems and should not be downloaded separately from these links.

Auto-upgrade

For states using auto-upgrade, the ASE-Q/LTCSP upgrade will be posted by COB on Friday October 21. For CMS Regional Office users, all applications will be deployed automatically to your computers through the auto-upgrade process beginning with logons after close of business on Friday, October 21.

Transition Information

We recommend all survey team members use the same version of LTCSP; either all upgrading to ASEQ/LTCSP version 12.2.0 or all continuing to use ASEQ/LTCSP version 12.0.

If a survey is exported from ACO version 12.2.0, ensure the survey team has upgraded to ASEQ/LTCSP version 12.2.0 prior to going out in the field. The new functionality will not be fully implemented until the application is updated.

Note: If a survey team does have some team members who upgrade to version 12.2.0 and some who do not, any data gathered using the new features in version 12.2.0 may be lost.

If teams are mid-survey at the time of release or the team is working with a survey shell exported using ACO version 12.0, we recommend all team members postpone updating until they complete their current survey.

If the team has not yet begun a survey using a shell exported using ACO version 12.0, the shell can be re-exported answering Yes to the recalculation question and team members would then all upgrade to ASEQ/LTCSP version 12.2.0. The survey team would then be able to use all the new functionality during the survey.

If the team does upgrade mid-survey, they will see some but not all phase 3 functionality. For instance, the Arbitration question will be available on the Entrance Conference screen, but the Arbitration task will not be available, and there will not be a side menu on the Finalize Sample screen tracking investigation coverage.

Release Notes

General/Menus

Add Residents for Task icon

In order to easily add residents to facility tasks from any screen, the Add Residents for Task icon was added to the Quick Access menu.

To add residents to facility tasks:

- 1. Select the 'Add Resident for Task' icon in the Quick Access menu.
- 2. Select the residents to add to the facility task.
- 3. Open the drop-list and select the facility task.
- 4. Select OK to save changes.




Figure 1: Select Add Resident to Facility Task icon to open Choose Resident screen

Additional Updates

- Reordered main navigation menu.
- MDS indicators were refined to increase the quality of selection of offsite selected residents.

Offsite Prep

CASPER PBJ Staffing Concerns and Notes

CASPER PBJ staffing concerns and staffing waivers can now be entered on the Offsite Preparation screen and are accessible via PBJ Staffing links from the Interview and Observations screen, the staffing concerns sections on the Team Meeting screens, and in Facility Tasks, for CE11 on the Resident Council pathway, and at the top (beside the Pathway link) of Sufficient and Competent Nurse Staffing.




Figure 2: Staffing Concerns and Notes section of Offsite Preparation screen

Additional Updates

- SAs can enter the majority of the Offsite Prep information in ACO before exporting the survey to ASE-Q (excluding outstanding complaint/FRIs, CASPER 3 review, and CASPER PBJ Staffing Data Report information).
- The active Complaints/FRIs section is expanded by default to ensure the TC links complaint allegations to LTCSP areas.

Entrance Conference

- Updated worksheet for new line items.
- Added a new question to the screen to determine whether the facility has asked residents/representatives to enter into a binding arbitration agreement. A response of Yes will trigger the Arbitration facility task.

Team Meeting

- Team Meeting Day 1 and Day 2 labels changed to Initial Pool and Investigation respectively.
- Team members can view Team Meeting in read only mode.
- Added new line items (e.g., identify compliance and ethics concerns).

Initial Pool

- Closed record/discharge reasons are now: Expired, Hospitalized, Unplanned (Facility Initiated) Discharge, and Planned (Resident Initiated) Discharge.
- When adding a new resident, the subgroup defaults to New Admissions.
- Updated initial pool area probes.

Finalize Sample

 New screen layout includes slide-out menu (to easily ensure all areas are sampled) and sort features, and Harm/IJ column is added back.




Figure 3: Finalize Sample

- The Team Coordinator is now required to finalize the closed records before starting sample finalization.
- The View Current Workload link is removed from the Finalize Sample and Finalize Closed Record Sample screens.
- Residents who only have facility task concerns can now be included in the sample size.

<u>Assignments</u>

Investigation Assignments screen

The LTCSP application assigns the surveyors to the residents they added during the initial pool process. Surveyors can be reassigned to better distribute the workload before or after finalizing the sample or conducting investigations from the Investigation Assignments screen.

Infection Control, Dining, and Sufficient and Competent Nurse Staffing allow the team coordinator to identify the surveyor who has primary responsibility.

To view workload:

 Click the View Current Workload link on the Facility Tasks or Investigations screen, or select Assignments from the Navigation menu.




Figure 4: Investigation Assignments

Facility Tasks

Arbitration

The Arbitration task is triggered immediately if Resident Council question #24 is answered Yes, or if the arbitration question above Notes in Entrance Conference is answered Yes.

For any resident listed or added to the Arbitration facility task screen, use the drop-list in the Reason field to identify the reason each resident was selected.




Figure 5: Arbitration

Additional Updates

- Updated pathway forms.
- The text and critical elements are switched on the screen to more closely match the pathway forms.
- Residents where the first critical element for an Abuse investigation was found as not in compliance are listed in the QAPI/QAA facility task.
- Residents marked FI during the initial pool for Infections (non-UTI, PU, Respiratory) and TBP are automatically listed in the Infection Control facility task.
- The Primary surveyor responsible for all CEs can be identified for Dining Observation, Infection Control, and Sufficient and Competent Nurse Staffing.

Investigations

- Moved the checkmark indicating completed Investigations next to the investigation name (not in front of resident name) and added a completion check next to resident's name once all care area investigations are complete.
- Hide Completed Investigations checkbox is checked by default.

Potential Citations

 New Singular Event and Start/End Date fields, including a link to the definitions, are available for tags cited for Harm or Immediate Jeopardy (scope/severity J, K, or L).




Figure 6: Potential Citations

Comparative Surveys

 Review FMS Report Data feature was added to ARO for preparing the Federal Monitoring Survey Documentation report which was updated.

To access and use the Review FMS Report Data window:

- 1. In **ARO**, right-click the LTCSP Comparative survey in the Tree and select **FMS Citation Compare**.
- 2. In the FMS Compare Options window, select the **Review FMS Report Data** tab.

To print the Federal Monitoring Survey Documentation Report:

- In ARO, right-click your survey in the tree and select LTCSP Documentation Reports (confidential).
- 2. All reports are selected by default, click **De-select All** and then select the **Federal Monitoring Survey**.
- 3. Click **Print**. A PDF of the report opens.
