- Entry of Registry Information



Typical Enforcement Case Example

- PT Desk review entered as Stand Alone survey by SA – cited 2 tags
- SA notifies RO of findings
- RO determines PT Desk Review Non-Initial should be started

Begin Enforcement Cycle



- Survey Category shows PTRVW
- Type Of Event default is blank
- You can create a CLIA enforcement case without a survey. Type of Event would be:
 - PT Desk Review Initial
 - PT Desk Review Non-Initial
 - Action By Inspector General
