

iQIES Deeming Updates

Recent Updates to Deeming

- Label updates to reflect **Deemed** for statuses and dates.
- Implemented consistent logic for the CMS Approval history.
- Fixed impacted records where CMS Approval and approval dates were missing.

Deeming Dates Explained

- **Deemed Accreditation Date**
The original effective date of the provider's first approved **Deemed** status.
- **Initial Deemed Accreditation Date**
The first approved deemed accreditation cycle effective date for any specific Accreditation Organization (AO).
- **Current Deemed Accreditation date**
The latest deemed accreditation cycle effective date for any specific AO.

CMS Approval Explained

- **CMS Approval of Deemed Status**

After the State Agency adds the first AO record, iQIES requires approval in the system by the CMS location. This approval is done one time and carries forward to any subsequent AO deeming cycles until a status change to non-deemed occurs.

- **Approval Date (CMS)**

The initial CMS approval for any 3-year deeming cycle. This date will be captured on the first AO record and will carry forward to any subsequent AO deeming cycles until a status change to non-deemed occurs.
