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1. Technical Help Questions

1.1 How do I register for iQIES?

- Create an account in the <u>HCQIS Access Roles and Profile Management (HARP)</u> system.
- Verify your identity.
- Log in to <u>iQIES</u> with your HARP credentials.
- <u>Request a user role</u>.

2.1 How do I log into iQIES when I'm Offline?

You can simply launch the browser you use iQIES in and sign in as you normally would online.

2.2 Does iQIES still time out after 15-minutes when I'm Offline?

Yes. The timeout is a requirement for iQIES Offline.

2.3 Is there a two-factor authentication for when I am Offline?

No.

2.4 Is there an Offline user manual?

2.5 Are there how-to videos?

2.6 Are forms available Offline?

All forms are available for Offline use.

2.7 What functionality is available for Offline?

Please refer to the <u>S&C User Manual: Offline</u> for the latest Offline functionality, but the goal of Offline functionality is to allow surveyors to complete surveys while their computers are offline.

2.8 Do I need to do anything when I get back online?

The system automatically synchronizes any changes as soon as you get back online.

2.9 What happens when there is more than one surveyor who documents at the same time?

Saving documents offline works exactly as saving documents online. The data is saved for the last person in an area. Citation findings and Notes remain user specific and they can be merged when you are back online.
